SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The Arts of Kenmore (AOK) is seeking **original** artworks by emerging artists in grades 6-12, to exhibit in the 7th annual Youth Art Show-Juried Competition at Kenmore City Hall gallery space, May 1-July 15, 2020. Encouraging healthy competition that supports artistic growth, portfolios for college applications, and recognition for creative endeavors!

SELECTION & AWARD PROCESS

The Jury Panel consists of representatives from the Arts of Kenmore organization and the Gallery Curator. Selected artworks will be considered on composition, artistry, technique, skill, and originality. Entries will be juried & awarded in 3 levels: grades 6-8 (middle school), and grades 9-10 and 11-12 (high school). Approximately 30 pieces will be selected for display.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Submissions must be original artworks within the following parameters to be considered:

- 2-Dimensional in any medium: Painting/Drawing, Digital Graphics, Photography, Artisan, Mixed media, etc.
- Prints and reproductions are disqualified, except for Digital Graphics.
- No copyright or trademark infringement of any third party or any laws (no Disney).
- Explicit subject matter in any format may be declined according to municipal policies.
- Works must be executed with permission by the subject.
- Student artwork produced under the supervision of an instructor is acceptable.
- Entries must not have been shown at a prior AOK Gallery exhibit, nor based on previously published work.
- Maximum framed size H60" x W36"

JPEG LABEL: Submission Jpeg must state **Title Medium Dimensions** (height x width), i.e., **SummerDays_Textile_18x20**

- *Show artwork only!* Keep it straight, no angles, no frame or background, no shadows or light spots. *Thank you!*

UPON ACCEPTANCE

- **Artists Indemnity Waiver & Release** form (details upon acceptance)
- Artist's Bio, statement, and headshot (selfie)
- Artwork must be prepared for hanging! Framed and/or mounted with D-Rings across the back works best.
- Entrants are encouraged, but not required, to price works for sale. AOK requests 10% commission on all sales.
- Entries must remain on display for duration of exhibition unless approved and accommodated by curator.
- AOK reserves the right to use accepted artwork images on variety current and future promotional materials.

April 20, 2020 **ENTRY DEADLINE** 11:59 PST – *Enter early, don't wait until the last minute!*

April 22 Jury Selection Announced via email

April 29 Art Intake 1-3pm – Accepted works must be hand delivered in timely manner or by appointment*

May 1 Opening Reception 6:30-8pm – Awards presentation, entertainment & light refreshments

July 15 Exhibit ends – Takedown 4-5pm – Unsold artworks must be picked up in timely manner or by appointment*

- AOK Gallery does not manage office or storage space at Kenmore City Hall. If you are unable to deliver or pick-up artwork at designated times you are encouraged to make arrangements with fellow artists, family and/or friends.
- Artwork not picked up within 90 days becomes property of AOK.
